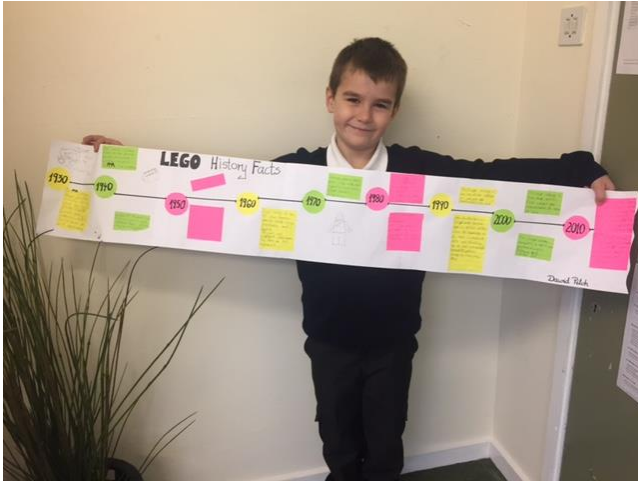
HELP YOUR CHILDREN READ – WEDNESDAY 25th JANUARY
